Global Macro, Policy, and the Shifting World Order

This session explores the mechanics, motivations, and market implications of these “shadow bailouts.” Participants will use LSEG Workspace to track policy announcements, central bank balance sheets, and market reactions. The goal is to understand how these tools shape risk perception and asset pricing.
